Dismantling the Doctrine of Discovery - Assembly of First Nations

Such breaches of natural justice serve to further discredit these rulings and the doctrine on which they are based. Discovery was used as a tool to attempt the “exclusive power to extinguish” Indigenous rights on an ongoing basis.2 The pre-existing inherent sovereignty of Indigenous Peoples was not considered.
